## **Autumn Taught Content**

- The environment, revision of time frames and tenses
- Revision of future tenses, future plans
- Revision and consolidation of modal verbs
- Exam technique, i.e. Speaking photo cards and general conversation
- Writing practice, 90 and 150 word questions
- Charity work, homelessness, unemployment and poverty
- Revision of adverbs
- Listening, reading, speaking, writing and translation practice

## **Spring Taught Content**

- Preparation for speaking mock, role plays, photo cards and general conversation

#### Assessment

There are 3 formal assessments throughout the year. One every term. There are also mini informal assessments (vocabulary tests, grammar tests etc) in order to assess progress and inform us for reports.

Homework will normally consist of learning homework for the tests, finishing classwork. There will also be at least one written homework per half term.
