

Turing Scheme Funding

We are very excited to be able to announce that we have been successful in our application to the Turing Scheme and have secured complete funding for the 2024 Trip to Cambodia. This means that the students and staff lucky enough to go on the trip will be fully funded by the Turing Scheme, so there are no barriers to anyone being able to go on the trip.

The trip is open to the current year 11s who will be at the end of Y12 in the summer of 2024 when the trip departs. The students have already applied to go on the trip and there will be interviews and practical assessments at the start of the next academic year to decide which of the applicants will be offered a place on this once in a lifetime trip.

The trip is being organised through our twin parish in Siem Reap, Cambodia. The parish, under the leadership of Fr Totet, is arranging for us to take the students into three different schools/settings where they will teach English to Cambodian children. The staff on the trip will also be working with the teachers in Cambodia to help them with their English teaching techniques.

The trip promises to be an amazing experience for those lucky enough to go on it. The students and staff will get to experience a completely new culture in a developing country. They will learn new skills, make new friends and gain an understanding of how Cambodia is moving forwards, away from its recent, difficult past.
