#### Assessment & Homework

Informal assessments once per half term.

Formal assessment point 1 will take place in November and will cover content and skills studied during the Autumn term 1. The assessment will be comprised of a listening comprehension task, reading comprehension tasks and a translation task. Formal assessment point 2 will take place in the summer term and will be based on the content and skills covered over the course of the year. It will be similar in format to the assessment point 1.

One piece of homework set once per fortnight. Examples of homework tasks set: pronunciation/vocabulary practice, extension of classwork and revision for assessment/mini test
