#### **Assessment & Homework**

Assessment Point 1 will take place in the second half term in November. This will be a short dictation and a writing paper on the topic of holidays.

The Year 9 exam (AP2) will take place at the same time as for other subjects, in the summer term. The exam will consist of the skills and topics needed for GCSE and will be actual Foundation past paper questions on topics we have covered.

Homework is given regularly and is generally finishing written work started in class, learning/revising a grammar point, learning vocabulary etc.
