Assessment & Homework

Their Mock exam takes place on the first half of Summer Term. We evaluate them in Reading, Listening and Writing.

In July we hold the Speaking assessment where the students are evaluated in this skill.

Throughout the year the students have vocabulary tests and mini grammar exams every half term.

The pupils have homework every week. The duration of homework could be wide-ranging between 20 minutes to 60 minutes. The style of homework varies depending on the unit that they are learning and the grammar. It could be a set of grammar exercises, revise vocabulary, writing or reading task, completing a Speaking Booklet or Reading Booklet.

Resources

Our students have a variety of resources such as Useful Grammar Booklet, Knowledge organiser Year 10, Reading booklets.

They can access Kerboodle to practice listening and reading skills and grammar as well.

Also, they can use Quizlet for practicing vocabulary. We have a link where our pupils can practise, but also there are plenty of resources in this website.

Our lessons use a variety of books to get the best activities for our pupils, such as Kerboodle, Viva, Mira, etc.

Extra and Super Curricular Opportunities

The school has a Native Spanish speaker as an assistant, and she works with small groups of Year 10 students after Easter.



The students are able to practise their speaking with our Spanish assistant in order to improve pronunciation, accent and of course, grammar and vocabulary. These extra opportunities will provide and enhance their confidence in using the Spanish language.
