Assessment & Homework

The Mock exam (AP1) will take place at the same time as for other subjects, at the end of November for two weeks. The exam will consist of the skills and topics needed for GCSE and will be actual past paper questions.

The Speaking mock will take place in February and will be a past paper format too.

We will also do lots of past paper questions throughout year 11, as well as whole question papers.

Homework is given regularly and is generally finishing written work started in class, learning/revising a grammar point, learning vocabulary etc.
