

Civil Service Talk from former student Anya Kemble



On Wednesday 2nd February, former student Anya Kemble gave a fascinating talk, via Microsoft Teams, to our Year 12 Politics students about her experience of working as a Lead Policy Adviser for the Civil Service.

The students really enjoyed hearing about Anya's route into the Civil Service, which involved gaining an Upper Second Class Honours degree in Political Science and Government at the London School of Economics and then successfully applying for a place on the Civil Service Fast Stream programme.

Anya then told us about some of the exciting projects she has been involved in since joining the Civil Service in her roles as a Policy Designer and Senior Policy Designer in the Department of Education working on projects such as supporting the delivery of 'Apply for Teacher Training', a new application system for graduates to apply for teacher training in England; and supporting the delivery of devices to children and young people to support home learning during the Covid-19.

Currently, Anya is working as a Lead Policy Advisor within the Department of Justice, which has involved working on several exciting initiatives, including a project to help separating couples reach settlements without using the court system.

The students were inspired by hearing about Anya's experiences within the Civil Service, particularly by her working so closely with cabinet ministers such as Gavin Williamson and Dominic Raab. They were also interested to hear about the core values of the Civil Service, the Civil Service code and the role of special advisers (SpAds).

At the end of the talk, the students were able to ask Anya questions about her career so far and the role of the Civil Service. One of the questions was about Anya's career ambitions within the Civil Service, which Anya answered – and we have no doubt that she will achieve them. We would like to say a huge thank you to Anya for taking time out of her busy day to talk to us and inspire the next generation of public servants.
